Description:

GA 215 is a high solids adhesive specifically designed for exceptional performance on paper and cardboard. Supplied as a light, non-drip paste it can easily be spread, rolled or brush applied. **GA 215** has excellent wet out properties and so it will bond well to uncoated paper and to many coated papers. Ideal for medium and heavy paper bonding in bag manufacture and packaging and also as a remoistenable adhesive for envelopes. **GA 215** has excellent adhesion to glass and is well suited for labelling applications. Non acidic to avoid paper yellowing. **GA 215** is off-white in colour when wet and dries clear to a near invisible glueline. **GA 215** is non-toxic and fully biodegradable.

GA 215 complies with United States FDA Regulations 21 CFR section 170.30, 21 CFR section 184.1005 and 21 CFR section 175.105 as a packaging adhesive for indirect contact with aqueous and/or fatty foods.
